Tap Faith, a 501c3 nonprofit, under the leadership of Jim Martin, Gene Louis, the Tap Faith Trustees and with the support of individuals, business and government; propose to create a revolutionary solution to ease the homeless crisis in Sussex County Delaware. We seek to organize the establishment of a new concept in community housing for the homeless.

The project proposes a transitional solution for homeless, jobless people, seeking to achieve self-sufficiency.

The project features the utilization of micro houses, supported by a main house facility and 'a program' to enable transition from homelessness to self-sufficiency.

Estimated cost of the proposal:

- Acquire a property of sufficient size Budget \$100,000
 - Land clear 3 acres \$6k

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 Installation of gravel roads, a parking lot and pathways - \$25k

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• Purchase ten 12'x16' micro homes \$100,000

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 Purchase a manufactured main house for showers, toilets, computer access, various utilities and washer/dryers cost - \$60k

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 Install wells and septic sufficient for main house \$45k

Estimated Budget to open - \$336,000.00

The Micro Home Community Project 'Program'

The program would offer the **Tap Faith 'Life Skills'** program to vetted homeless individuals for their enrichment and the re-learning of life skills necessary for self-sufficiency.

The program would Implement and offer job seeking education. Utilizing computers, resume printing and job referrals for vetted individuals residing in the Micro Housing offered by the project.




A 192 square foot Micro House floor plan

LIFE SKILLS CIRRICULUM

| Subject Money Management | Topics Budgeting and savings, balancing a checkbook checking account, improving/fixing credit issues. |
|-----------------------------|---|
| Employability Skills | Resume formats and content, filling out a job application, interviewing skills. |
| Healthy Relationships | Family relationships, marital/romantic relationships, friends/co-worker relationships, communication skills. |
| Nutrition and Cooking | Outline of a balanced diet, how to read and understand food labels, how unhealthy foods affect the body, meal planning, food shopping creating a grocery list. |
| Stress and Anger Management | Relaxation techniques, coping skills, involvement in leisure activities |
| Parenting Skills | Understanding basic child development, methods of disciplining children, how substance abuse affects parenting skills |
| Independent Living Skills | Apartment hunting, managing finances and paying Bills, employability skills, applying for financial assistance/college loans, meal planning and food shopping. |
| Pastoral Counseling | Recognizing addiction, how substance abuse affects families and communities, the role of a "higher power" or religion in recovery, appropriate roles and interventions. |

Sussex County Code § 115-87**Conditional uses.**

The following uses **may be permitted** as conditional uses when approved in accordance with the provisions of Article **XXIV** of this chapter:

Camps, day and boarding, private or commercial

TENTING AREA

Any park, tourist park, camp, court, site, lot, parcel or tract of land which is designed, maintained or intended for the purpose of supplying a location or accommodation for two or more tents, tent trailers, camp trailers, trailerettes or other camping vehicles or facilities as temporary living or sleeping quarters for persons engaged in recreational, educational or vacation activities.
